Electrofringe Ltd runs an international, year-round program of experimental electronic arts and culture including the annual Electrofringe conference and festival at This is Not Art in Newcastle. The organisation is dedicated to artform development through skills development and artistic exchange with a special emphasis on early career opportunities and accessibility. This Is Not Art (TINA) festival is Australia's largest gathering of artists, activists and commentators and is made up of five independent conference/festivals of which Electrofringe is the largest. The other festivals are National Young Writers Festival, Sound Summit, Critical Animals (Postgraduate Students Conference) and TIN Radio. Electrofringe festival alone often represents the work of over 250 artists in over 100 events in five days.

This year marks the twelfth anniversary for Electrofringe and the beginning of a new company. The group incorporated as a not-for-profit Australian public company limited by guarantee in 2008 and the founding Directors are in the process of establishing an infrastructure for the organisation. Electrofringe relies on the input and support of the electronic arts community and embodies DIY culture. Board members will play a key part in establishing this infrastructure. Electrofringe is managed by a small volunteer artistic directorate and is a community based, artist-run organisation.
